Welcome to our second Annual Heartland District Junior Camp 2011. Camp dates this year are from August 3rd – 6th. We're asking that all campers try to arrive Wednesday evening, August 3rd. Check-in will be from 6:00 on and we will have snacks and a movie for the campers later in the evening. Camp will begin on Thursday at 8:00 A.M. and will end at noon on the 6th. We are looking forward to providing a great camping experience this year for all of our Junior youth, and we want your child to have a worshipful, fun, and safe experience with us.

To help us meet these objectives we ask that you have your child read this and the camp rules page and then sign his/her name along with yours at the bottom of the camp rules page. After signing, please mail this and the Information Record (or bring them to camp with your child) to: Mark Deitrick, 22866 E. 1680th St., Geneseo, IL 61254. This will be your child's reservation.

There is no charge for this camp. We do encourage donations to help with the costs. This year camp expenses will run approximately \$35.00 per camper. However, please don't feel pressured to send money or keep your child at home because of finances. We want ALL kids to attend camp. Arrangements are in place to cover camp expenses.

Remember that this is a camp and clothes will get dirty. We ask that you send a couple sets of clothing for play that you won't mind if they get dirty, wet, or muddy. We will not be swimming during this camp, but we will be having water activities on the grounds where your child will get wet. We suggest sending a bag along for dirty clothes.

There is nothing that your child will need to bring money for – and we encourage you not to send any money or valuables with them. The following are things that your child should/can bring with them to camp:

1. Scriptures

 3. Bedding, Towels & Toilet Articles
 4. Notebook & Pen
 5. Bug Spray
 6. Camera (recommend a disposable)
 7. Extra play clothes
 8. Bag for dirty clothes
 9. Swimwear and sunblock

Camp Rules

- The use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, etc., is prohibited at or during camp.
- Radios, Cell Phones, CD players, CDs, pop, and candy are not permitted at camp.
- All campers are to be in their sleeping quarters during Lights Out.
- Boys are not allowed in girls' quarters and vice versa.
- Campers must wear shoes at all times unless given permission to do otherwise.
- No littering.
- Campers may not leave the campgrounds without staff permission.
- Living quarters must be kept clean.
- Attendance at all planned activities is required.
- Fighting, stealing, or swearing will not be tolerated.

For your child to be able to attend camp, the Camp Information Record must be filled out and the following statement signed:

By signing this form, you are acknowledging and promising that you will not hold the Church of Jesus Christ, Geneseo Restoration Branch of Geneseo, Illinois, the church's membership, nor the staff of the Heartland District Junior Camp liable for any injuries or accidents which may involve or happen to your child while attending camp.

By signing this form you are also granting the director and his/her staff authority to secure emergency medical, surgical treatment for your child while attending camp if there is insufficient time to contact you. You are also giving the camp director and his/her staff permission to secure routine, nonsurgical medical care for your child while attending camp.

Acknowledge that I am aware that the Geneseo campgrounds carry only liability insurance and that, if necessary, my insurance carrier will be the primary insurance.

Give my consent and authorization to the Junior Camp and its successors and representatives to use and reproduce my child's name, voice and/or likeness (photos, audio recordings, videos, electronic or digital image) for any official resource, use, or purpose including print, film, electronic media and reproduction or digital representation of every description on the internet/world wide web without compensation. Consideration is hereby waived in perpetuity and no further claim of any nature whatsoever shall be made by me, my heirs, or assigns.
